

Crown hat

design by Hanna Maciejewska

"Crown" is an unisex, slouchy style hat with textured brim.

Materials

* Dye Dye Done Yakalicious DK (60% Merino, 20% Silk, 20% Yak) 115g/231 yards (211 meters); 1 skein or approx. 190 yards (175 meters) of DK weight yarn that knits up to gauge.

The sample is knit with "Currcuma" colorway.

- * US 4 [3.5 mm] & 6 [4 mm] 16" (40 cm) circular needles or DPNs
- * Cable needle
- * One stitch marker
- * Tapestry needle

One Size

To fit an average adult head. Will stretch to comfortably fit up to 24" (61 cm).

Gauge

22 sts and 28 rounds per 4" [10 cm] in reverse Stockinette stitch with larger needles after blocking.

Make sure to obtain correct gauge; adjust needle size if needed.

Directions

Using smaller circular needle and your favorite cast on method, CO 96 sts. Place marker for beginning and join sts to work in the round, being careful not to twist.

Ribbing

Round 1 - ribbing: * K1tbl, p1; repeat from * to end.

Repeat ribbing round 13 more times.

Body

Change to bigger needles and continue with Texture Pattern. Please refer to chart on page 3 or to written instructions below.

Round 1: *[K1tbl, p1] 8 times, M1RP; rep. from * to end. [6 sts inc; 102 sts]

Round 2: *[K1tbl, p1] 8 times, p1; rep. from * to end.

Round 3: *K1tbl, [p1, k1tbl] 6 times, 1/1 RPfbC, p2; rep. from * to end. [6 sts inc; 108 sts]

Round 4: *[K1tbl, p1] 6 times, k2tbl, p4; rep. from * to end.

Round 5: *[K1tbl, p1] 6 times, 1/1 RPfbC, p4; rep. from * to end. [6 sts inc; 114 sts]

Round 6: *[K1tbl, p1] 7 times, p5; rep. from * to end.

Round 7: *K1tbl, [p1, k1tbl] 5 times, 1/1 RPfbC, p6; rep. from * to end. [6 sts inc; 120 sts]

Round 8: *[K1tbl, p1] 5 times, k2tbl, p8; rep. from * to end.

Round 9: *[K1tbl, p1] 5 times, 1/1 RPC (tbl), p8; rep. from * to end.

Round 10: *[K1tbl, p1] 6 times, p8; rep. from * to end.

Round 11: *K1tbl, [p1, k1tbl] 4 times, 1/1 RPC (tbl), p9; rep. from * to end.

Round 12: *[K1tbl, p1] 4 times, k2tbl, p10; rep. from * to end.

Round 13: *[K1tbl, p1] 4 times, 1/1 RPC (tbl), p10; rep. from * to end.

Round 14: *[K1tbl, p1] 5 times, p10; rep. from * to end.

Round 15: * K1tbl, [p1, k1tbl] 3 times, 1/1 RPC (tbl), p11; rep. from * to end.

Round 16: *[K1tbl, p1] 3 times, k2tbl, p12; rep. from * to end.

Round 17: *[K1tbl, p1] 3 times, 1/1 RPC (tbl), p12; rep. from * to end.

Round 18: *[K1tbl, p1] 4 times, p12; rep. from * to end.

Round 19: * K1tbl, [p1, k1tbl] twice, 1/1 RPC (tbl), p13; rep. from * to end.

Round 20: *[K1tbl, p1] twice, k2tbl, p14; rep. from * to end.

Round 21: *[K1tbl, p1] twice, 1/1 RPC (tbl), p14; rep. from * to end.

Round 22: *[K1tbl, p1] 3 times, p14; rep. from * to end.

Round 23: *K1tbl, p1, k1tbl, 1/1 RPC (tbl), p15; rep. from * to end.

Round 24: *K1tbl, p1, k2tbl, p16; rep. from * to end.

Round 25: * K1tbl, p1, 1/1 RPC (tbl), p16; rep. from * to end.

Round 26: *[K1tbl, p1] twice, p16; rep. from * to end.

Round 27: *K1tbl, 1/1 RPC (tbl), p17; rep. from * to end.

Round 28: *K2tbl, p18; rep. from * to end.

Round 29: *K2tog, p18; rep. from * to end. [6 sts dec; 114 sts]

Round 30: *K1tbl, p18; rep. from * to end.

Next Round: Purl to end.

Continue in reverse st st until hat measures approx. 7.75" [20 cm].

Continue with Crown Shaping.

Next Round 1: * P9, p2tog, p8; rep. from * to end. [6 sts dec; 108 sts]

Next Round 2: Purl to end.

Next Round 3: * P8, p2tog, p8; rep. from * to end. [6 sts dec; 102 sts]

Next Round 4: Purl to end.

Next Round 5: * P8, p2tog, p7; rep. from * to end. [6 sts dec; 96 sts]

Next Round 6: * P7, p2tog, p7; rep. from * to end. [6 sts dec; 90 sts]

Next Round 7: * P7, p2tog, p6; rep. from * to end. [6 sts dec; 84 sts]

Next Round 8: * P6, p2tog, p6; rep. from * to end. [6 sts dec; 78 sts]

Next Round 9: * P5, p3tog, p5; rep. from * to end. [12 sts dec; 66 sts]

Next Round 10: * P4, p3tog, p4; rep. from * to end. [12 sts dec; 54 sts]

Next Round 11: * P3, p3tog, p3; rep. from * to end. [12 sts dec; 42 sts] **Next Round 12:** * P2, p3tog, p2; rep. from * to end. [12 sts dec; 30 sts]

Next Round 13: * P1, p3tog, p1; rep. from * to end. [12 sts dec; 18 sts]


Next Round 14: P3tog to end. [12 sts dec; 6 sts]

Finishing

Cut the yarn and thread through remaining stitches, tighten and fasten off.

Weave in all ends, and wet-block the hat. Enjoy ©

Stitches No stitch p k1tbl M1RP k2tog 1/1 RPfbC

Abbreviations:

1/1 RPfbC = slip 1 stitch to cable needle and hold in back; k1tbl;

pfb from cable needle; (1 st inc)

1/1 RPC (tbl) = slip 1 stitch to cable needle and hold in back; k1tbl;

P1 from cable needle;

CO = cast on sts;

dec = decreased;

DPNs = double pointed needles;

inc = increased;

 $\mathbf{k} = \text{knit};$

k tbl = knit through back loop;

k2tog = knit two sts together;

M1RP = from the back, lift the horizontal strand between stitches with the left needle and purl through the front loop;

 $\mathbf{p} = \text{purl};$

p2tog = purl two sts together;

p3tog = purl three sts together;

pfb = purl into the front of the stitch, leaving the stitch on the needle, and then purl into the back of the same stitch;

Reverse st st = reverse stockinette stitch = purl all sts;

St/s = stitch/stitches;
